

ADVANCED STUDIO PRACTICE PORTFOLIO REQUIREMENTS

To ensure that you are well prepared for entry into this Program, we need to assess the development of your studio practice. Please provide the following:

1. Artist CV
2. A letter of intent (max 500 words) which includes your:
 - Reasons for wanting to undertake this program of study
 - Professional goals; and
 - Influences on your studio practice including creative processes, techniques and contemporary practitioners and/or historical periods that have informed your thinking.
3. Letters of Reference – sent directly from the recommender to registrar by email. NBCCDRegistrar@gnb.ca.
 - At least one academic reference.
 - Reference should speak to your artistic potential and abilities
4. A sample of written work – essay, published article or other relevant text demonstrating your writing abilities.
5. Samples of your work (10-15) with a clearly labeled image list, including titles, medium, dimensions and year of creation. Your submission may contain any of the following:
 - Weblinks, a personal website or on-line portfolio, audio or video files to a third-party service such as Vimeo, YouTube or SoundCloud;
 - If uploading files to a third-party service like Google Drive, please provide the viewing link (URL) and the password if one is required;
 - Audio/Video clips should be no longer than 10 minutes total.
 - Images must be submitted in JPEG format and should be no larger than 1600 pixels on the longest dimension. If emailing submissions, individual files should be no larger than 1mb in size. A PDF portfolio of images is also acceptable, but must be no larger than 10mb if it is submitted through email.
 - The image list must be submitted as a Word or PDF document.
6. Candidates may be required to attend an interview with two faculty members for the opportunity to further discuss your application.

Your portfolio can be submitted to the Registrar via email, or manually on a CD, DVD or USB key, or upload to a third-party service like Google Drive.
