#### Summer edVentures @NBCCD

- The Summer edVentures program will run between July 4<sup>th</sup> and July 17<sup>th</sup> 2020.
- All courses will take place at the New Brunswick College of Craft and Design in downtown Fredericton at 457 Queen Street.  
Our 1 – 2 days workshops will run during on the weekends and 3 – 5 day classes will run Monday – Friday.
- Courses will run from 9:00 am – 4:00 pm.
- Participants and instructors will have access to the College store for purchase of course materials.
- We have well equipped studio spaces to suit a variety of needs and projects. Please specify what you will need access to in your application; we will do our best to put your course in the room requested.
- Safety is a priority for us at NBCCD. Therefore, if you are new applicant seeking to use any of our equipment an interview with one of our Studio Heads may be required prior to your acceptance.

#### Summer edVentures @KingsLanding

- Workshops at Kings Landing are scheduled each weekend throughout July and August, and will take place at 5804 NB-102, Prince William, a 30-minute drive from Fredericton.
- We are primarily looking for half day and full day workshops. Full day workshops will run from 10:00 am – 4:00 pm. Half-day workshops will run from 1:00 pm – 4:00 pm.
- Workshops will take place in the Welcome Center. The room is equipped with tables and chairs. There is a sinks a short walk across the hall, and electric outlets are available around the room. It is a large space, located next to the shop and café.
- Accessing the site during your workshop is encouraged; please just let us know in your application if you plan on accessing the historical site, as we will have to confirm your group's entry with the front desk.
