



ADVANCED STUDIO PRACTICE APPLYING FOR ADMISSION

Applicants must:

1. Submit an online application and fee online.
2. Upload an application package at the following link: [Portfolio Upload - New Brunswick College of Craft and Design \(nbccd.ca\)](https://www.nbccd.ca/PortfolioUpload)
3. Have an official transcript of marks submitted to the Admissions Office via NBCCD.admissions@gnb.ca.

Applications submitted by May 15 will be reviewed in the first round of jurying and will automatically be considered for the Sheila Hugh Mackay Foundation Merit Bursary Program. This bursary will be awarded to a qualified student that demonstrates excellence in their portfolio.

Applications submitted after May 15 will be reviewed as received until spaces are filled. Once the program is full, a waitlist will be maintained.

Advanced Studio Practice applicants must have a diploma in art or design (or equivalent).

The following documents must be uploaded to complete the application package:

- A clearly labeled **image list**, including titles, medium, dimensions, and year of creation.
- Images in **JPEG** format that are no larger than 1600 pixels on the longest dimension.
- If including audio/video submissions, please present a show reel no longer than 10 minutes in length.

SUBMISSION

Applications must be complete in order to be assessed.

Note: Audio and video files may be submitted separately too.

INTERVIEW

After all relevant documents have been assessed, an interview may be required to further evaluate suitability for the program.
