ABOUT THE PROGRAM

We have two different programs running simultaneously this summer: EdVentures @NBCCD and EdVentures Online. This application contains the forms for our online programming.

EdVentures Online

- Courses will operate through Google Classroom, and will be required to contain a variety
 of elements such as: downloadable handouts, a number of contact hours that can be
 recorded for later viewing, a space for students to share their work and interact with each
 other.
- Instructors can teach from the comfort of their home or studio, or on location at the NBCCD campus as required.
- These classes will require a minimum of five students and with a maximum of 15 students.
- One week prior to your course, or as soon as you have the minimum number of participants, instructors will be given the green light to get populating their Google Classroom!

APPLICATION FORM

Instructors will receive \$34/h as well as a \$25 material fee. For every two hours of contact time, instructors will receive one hour of payment to prepare digital resources and connect with students between classes. This is a general model and may be altered depending on the circumstance of the course.

The instructor will provide a minimum of one handout (or digital resource) each week and spend a half hour between sessions interacting with students online. (Three hours per week + a \$25 for materials/samples for three-week courses or a \$50 materials/samples for four-to-five-week courses)
