- reason for wanting to enroll in the Studio Studies program
- plans and goals for the future

3. 10 images to show us what you are all about:

- Either a Portfolio, with10 images of recent work and an image list (title, materials, date produced), or
- 10 images that demonstrate what you do, and a 1 sentence description for each image and how it is relevant to your practice.
