Apply by May 15 to be considered in the first round of jurying. Applications submitted after May 15 will be reviewed as received until spaces are filled. Once the program is full, a waitlist will be maintained. An application package is required to ensure that the applicant is well prepared for entry into our Studio Studies Program. Please note this program is only open to Canadian citizens and Permanent Residents.

- 10 images of recent work and an image list (title, materials, date produced), **or**
- 10 images that demonstrate what you do, and a one-sentence description for each image and how it is relevant to your practice.
